

# PAPER BAG SNOWFLAKES



Materials:

9 lunch bags per snowflake

scissors

glue (We used a hot glue gun, but elmer's would work too)

stapler

pencil

string

Draw your pattern on a bag and cut out (we cut 3 at a time), then trace onto your remaining bags and cut those out too so that all 9 match.

Place a line of glue down the center of the front of the bag, and along the bottom (forming an upside-down T). Repeat, gluing all bags together.

Fan out into a circle and staple together. add a string and tie them to your stairs, curtain rods, etc.
