

**ALBERT WISNER PUBLIC LIBRARY
NOTICE OF SPECIAL DISTRICT MEETING OF THE WARWICK VALLEY
CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR LIBRARY PURPOSES**

The Board of Trustees of the Albert Wisner Public Library, One McFarland Drive, Warwick, New York, HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that for Library purposes, a Special District Meeting of the qualified voters of the Warwick Valley Central School District will be held for the purpose of electing two individuals to the position of Library Trustee on May 18, 2021, between the hours of 7:00 AM and 9:00 PM, prevailing time, at the following locations:

In the First School Election District – Pine Island District – At the Pine Island Fire House located at 684 County Route 1, Pine Island, New York;

In the Second School Election District – Village District – At the Dorothy C. Wilson Education Center, in the Middle School addition, located at 225 West Street Extension, Warwick, New York;

In the Third School Election District – Kings District – At the Kings Elementary School located at 194 Kings Highway, Warwick, New York.

Pursuant to §260 of the state Education Law, one individual will be elected for a term of five (5) years and one individual will be elected to fill an unexpired term that ends in three (3) years. Petitions to nominate candidates shall be filed at the Albert Wisner Public Library between the hours of 10:00 AM and 5:00 PM not later than April 19, 2021. Petition forms are available at the Library or on the Library's website www.albertwisnerlibrary.org.

There will be no vote this year on a tax levy increase to fund the Library's annual operating budget, because the tax levy amount will remain the same for the 2021–2022 fiscal year as in the 2020–2021 fiscal year.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that a special informational meeting of the qualified voters of said School District will be held at the Albert Wisner Public Library, One McFarland Drive, Warwick, New York, on Tuesday May 4, 2021, at 7 PM, prevailing time, concerning the 2021-2022 budget. A copy of the budget will be available for review at the Library and on the Library's website on and after April 16, 2021.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to § 2014 of the Education Law, personal registration of voters is required, and no person shall be entitled to vote at said Special District Meeting whose name does not appear on the register of said School District or who does not register as hereafter provided, except a person who is otherwise qualified to vote and is registered under provisions of Article V of the Election Law. The Board of Registration shall prepare a register for said Special District Meeting, except that the register prepared for the last Annual Meeting or Election shall be used as the basis therefor and shall include all persons who shall have presented themselves personally for registration thereat, and also include, all persons who shall have been previously registered hereunder for any Annual or Special District Meeting or Election and who shall have voted at any Annual or Special District Meeting or Election held

or conducted at any time within four (4) years prior to the preparation of said year registered.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that walk-in registration will be available at the office of the School District Clerk, 225 West Street Extension, Warwick, New York, Monday through Friday, excluding School District holidays, from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM, prevailing time, until and including May 13, 2021.


The register prepared pursuant to § 2014 of the Education Law shall be filed in the office of the School District Clerk, West Street Extension, Warwick, New York, and will be open for inspection by any qualified voter in the district on each of the five (5) days prior to the date set for the Special District Meeting (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) between the hours of 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM, prevailing time.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots may be applied for at the District Clerk's office, 225 West Street Extension, Warwick, New York. Absentee ballots shall be provided in accordance with the policy for Absentee Ballot Voting Guidelines available at the office of the School District Clerk. Any such application must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the date of the aforesaid Special District Meeting if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter or the day before such Special District Meeting if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. A list of all persons to whom Absentee Ballots shall have been issued shall be available for public inspection at the District Clerk's office not less than five (5) days prior to the day that the Special District Meeting (excluding Saturdays and Sundays) during regular office hours until the date of the aforesaid Special District Meeting. In addition, said lists shall also be posted conspicuously at the place of the voting during the hours of such Special District Meeting. Absentee ballots must be received by the School District Clerk not later than 5:00pm on the day of the vote.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that Military Voters may register and/or obtain an application for a military ballot from the District Clerk by email: slaroe@wvcsd.org or by Telephone: (845) 987-3000, Ext. 10511 no later than 5:00 P.M. on April 22, 2021. The Military Voter may indicate a preference for receiving the application by mail, by facsimile or email. Military ballots will be mailed or otherwise distributed no later than 25 days before the election. Military ballots must be received by the District Clerk by 5:00 P.M. on election day, May 18, 2021, and showing a cancellation mark of the U.S postal service or a foreign country's postal service, or showing a dated endorsement of receipt by another agency of the U.S. government or signed and dated by the military voter and one witness thereof, with a date which is ascertained to be not later than the day before the election. A list of all persons to whom military ballots shall have been issued will be available for inspection by qualified voters of the District, upon request, until the day of the election. A military voter means a qualified voter of NYS who is in actual military service and will be absent from the District in which he or she is qualified to vote on the day of registration or election or is discharged from military service within 30 days of an election or a spouse, parent, child or dependent of the military voter if a qualified voter of New York State and a resident of the same school district as the military voter or military personnel residing on a military base within a school district in New York State for a period of 30 days immediately preceding the election.
