

# Museum Passes

***9/11 Memorial Museum*** (New York, NY): Free, expedited admission to the Museum for two adults and two children (17 and under). Memorial open Daily 8am - 8pm. Museum open Wednesday - Monday 9am - 7pm. Closed on Tuesdays.

***Boscobel House and Gardens*** (Garrison, NY): pass offers free admission for one adult and three guests of any age. Additional children ages 12 and under are also admitted for free.

***Brooklyn Botanic Garden*** (Brooklyn, NY): pass offers free admission for two adults and accompanying children ages 17 and under.

***Children's Museum of Manhattan*** (New York, NY): pass offers free admission for up to four people (please note: limit one per card per family; two adults and two children, or one adult and three children).

***Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum*** (New York, NY): pass offers free admission to one adult and any children under 18 years of age.

***DIA Beacon*** (Beacon, NY): pass offers free admission plus four additional guests.

***Edward Hopper House Museum*** (Nyack, NY): pass offers free admission for 2 adults and up to 4 children.

***Empire State Pass*** (New York State): for the pass holder and their occupants in ONE VEHICLE; offers free entry to most New York State-operated parks and recreational facilities.

***Franklin Delano Roosevelt Presidential Library and Museum*** (Hyde Park, NY): pass offers free admission for any size family. No need to make a reservation; it is a single-use pass and need not be returned to AWPL.

***Frick Collection*** (New York, NY) pass offers free admission for one adult. **Temporarily closed through late 2024 for relocation of collection.**

**Grey Towers National Historic Site** (Milford, PA): Each pass offers admission for the mansion tour for one adult. Check online for open hours.

**Hudson River Maritime Museum** (Kingston, NY) pass offers admission for one family.

**Hudson Highlands Nature Museum** (Cornwall, NY) pass offers free admission for two adults and accompanying children

**Intrepid Sea, Air and Space Museum Complex** (New York, NY): pass offers free admission for up to 6 adults and 6 children, entering once per day (please note: you must present your AWPL card upon admission along with pass).

**Liberty Science Center** (Jersey City, NJ): present your AWPL library card at the box office for a discount of 10% off admission (please note: Liberty Science Center does not offer a library museum pass for free admission).

**Mohonk Preserve** (Gardiner, NY): pass offers free admission for up to four people (ages 16 and up) in one vehicle; children 15 and younger are free when accompanied by an adult pass holder.

**Motorcyclepedia** (Newburgh, NY): the largest educational motorcycle museum in the world. Pass admits two.

**Museum of Modern Art (MoMA)** (New York, NY): pass offers free admission plus four additional guests.

**Museum at Bethel Woods** (Bethel, NY) pass offers free admission for four people, once a day.

**New-York Historical Society Museum and Library** (New York, NY): pass entitles entrance for two adults living at the same residence and up to four children under age 18.

**New York Transit Museum** (Brooklyn, NY): pass offers free admission to two adults and up to four children.

**Olana** (Hudson, NY): pass offers free admission to 2 adults. Children 12 and under are free, however they must be included in the reservation when calling. **Reservations are required.**

**Opus 40** (Saugerties, NY): pass offers free admission for two adults and all of their children, but not additional family members or friends.

**Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum** (New York, NY): pass offers free admission for up to four adults. Children under age 12 enter for free.

**Storm King Art Center** (New Windsor, NY): pass offers free admission for up to six people in one vehicle (children 5 and under need not be included in the count.)

**Westchester Children's Museum** (Rye, NY): pass admits 4 people, at least one of which is an adult. All children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Open daily 9am to 5pm.
