From the Director

2025 has been another year of growth here at Albert Wisner Public Library.

- We opened the year with two beautiful new small study rooms to accommodate patrons who work remotely, or who need to hold small meetings.
 The rooms are used at least 125 times per month.
- We hosted our first-ever Home School Expo to connect home school families with community resources and with one another.
- We launched a Homebound Delivery program to ensure that patrons who lack in-person access to the Library (because of illness, infirmity or lack of transportation) have access to all the Library's materials.
- We further expanded the Museum Pass program and the Library of Things, both generously sponsored by Glenn P. and Susan D. Dickes.
- We brought the Library to Schervier Pavilion to connect the residents there with books and fun activities.
- We welcomed 70 authors and illustrators and countless children to connect with one another over a shared love of the printed word. Glenn P. and Susan D. Dickes sponsor the Festival, which has become a beloved community event.
- We continued our efforts at sustainability, cultivating a pollinator garden and replacing the original parking lot lights with energy-efficient LED fixtures that are dark-sky compliant.


EXPANDING POSSIBILITIES
